As we have been about our Father's business we have many praiseworthy things to report.

August started out with me, flying to Fairbanks, Alaska, to meet with Northstar Bible Baptist Church. I trust the meeting was a blessing to them as their fellowship was to me. We enjoyed preaching on the street to multitudes entering into the fairgrounds at the annual fair in Fairbanks. What a great opportunity to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the lost and to edify the saved!
