For us, the month of May was a very busy one and a very good one! We found ourselves up in Michigan and Ohio, where God blessed us with many especially good meetings. It was full of many miles covered safely and many prayers answered to the glory of God! We hope it was just as good for you!

We had several close encounters with tornados recently which reminded us how God is in control and how the things he allows are only for our good. One Monday evening we had several of them touch down nearby us, suddenly, leaving us no time to run for cover. Although a dinky travel trailer provides miserable protection in storms like these, thank God we have cover in our Lord Jesus Christ, wherever we are! Although I was afraid our trailer would flip over as the 80 mph+ gusts of wind rocked it back and forth, we prayed and the Lord said, "peace, be still" and the storm obeyed. Two nights later we had more tornado warnings on the night of a meeting. When many people were running for cover, we praise the Lord that God's people came out anyway and we had one of the best meetings so far on deputation! God punctuated the slide presentation and preaching with lightning and thunder and kept us all in the safety of his care! Thanks for praying for our safety!
